COOKIES POLICY

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device (such as a computer or mobile phone) when you browse websites. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more effectively. They help us to distinguish you from other visitors. They also help us to customise our web pages by remembering your preferences, such as font size.

When you return to our websites, we use the information in the cookie to recognise your last session. This improves the quality of your experience on our websites.

2. How and why does Zotefoams use them?

We use cookies to gain a better understanding of how visitors use our website. Cookies help us tailor to your personal needs and to improve usability.

3. Storage and sharing of cookies.

We don't collect or store your personal information (for example, your name or address) so this information can't be used to identify who you are. The cookies simply enable us to see behaviour on the website to help us improve your experience. We do not share this data with third parties.

4. What types of cookie do we use?

The following types of cookies are used on our websites:

Necessary cookies These are cookies that are strictly necessary for the operation of the website. Without these, the website won't work properly, so we are not asking you for your specific consent for these cookies. For all other cookies your informed consent is required.

Session cookies Session cookies are temporary cookie files which are erased when you close your browser. When you restart your browser and go back to the website that created that cookie, the website will treat you as a new visitor.

Persistent cookies These are cookies which are set up to improve the functionality of the website.

5. How can I change my cookie settings?

Please ensure that your computer settings reflect whether you are happy to accept cookies or not. You can set your browser to warn you before accepting cookies, or you can simply set it to refuse them, although you may not have access to all the features of the website if you do so. Your browser's help section will advise how you can do this.

Please remember that if you use different computers in different locations, you will need to ensure that each browser is adjusted to suit your cookie preferences.
